



## 2024 Envirothon Scholarships and Awards

Scholarships:

- Warner College of Natural Resources: First-place team members will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship, second-place team members will receive \$750 each, and third place team members will receive \$500 scholarships to the CSU Warner College of Natural Resources. You must enroll in a degree within Warner College to receive the scholarship.
- 2. The College of Agriculture Sciences: First-place team members will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship, second-place team members will receive \$750 each, and third place team members will receive \$500 scholarships to the CSU College of Agriculture Sciences. You must enroll in a degree within the College of Ag Sciences to receive the scholarship.
- 3. The Office of Engagement and Extension (OEE): First-place team members will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship, second-place team members will receive \$750 each, and third place team members will receive \$500 scholarships. These scholarships can be used for ANY degree program at our CSU Ft. Collins or CSU Pueblo campuses.
- 4. You may be wondering if you get double the scholarships if you attend Warner College of Natural Resources or the College of Ag Sciences. The answer is yes. For example, if you were on the first-place team and enrolled in Warner College, you would receive the \$1,000 scholarship from Warner AND the \$1,000 from OEE!
- 5. We realize that the placing teams may have members who are not seniors. We will track their scholarship(s) until they graduate and are eligible for enrollment. Team members can only acquire scholarships for two years, regardless how many years they place in the Colorado Envirothon competition. More information will be provided to the placing team members.
- 6. The winning team is invited to compete in the North American Envirothon Competition: <u>https://envirothon.org/</u>, which will be held in Geneva, New York July 28-August 3, 2024. Teams compete for \$25,000 in scholarships. The Colorado Association of Conservation Districts (CACD) will cover the cost of the national registration, flights, lodging, and food during the competition timeframe (approximately \$8K this year for the team, including two adult advisors).
