



2023 Envirothon Scholarships and Awards

1. For 2023, **ALL** attendees will receive a \$1,000 scholarship to CSU (any degree) for completing the two-day event.
2. First-place team members will be awarded an additional \$1,000 scholarship to the CSU College of Ag Sciences (must take a degree in Ag Sciences).
3. Second-place members will receive an additional \$750 CSU scholarship (any degree at CSU) for a total of \$1,750 for any degree at CSU.
4. Third-place members receive an additional \$500 (any degree at CSU) for a total of \$1,500 toward any degree at CSU.
5. The winning team is invited to compete in the North American Envirothon Competition: <https://envirothon.org/>, which is held in New Brunswick, Canada July 23-28, 2023. Teams compete for \$25,000 in scholarships. The Colorado Association of Conservation Districts (CACD) will cover the cost of the national registration, flights, lodging, and food during the competition timeframe (approximately \$10K this year for the team, **including two adult advisors**).
6. We are still working with Warner College of Natural Resources to provide the same \$1,000 scholarship for the winning team. They would have to take a degree in Warner College to be eligible for this scholarship. Stay tuned for updates!
